Catholic Bishop of S. C.

I know all men by these presents, That J. Maria Louise Gwynn of the

County of Spartanburg in the State aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar
 to me in hand paid, and for the good will and
 regard & hold for the Holy Roman Catholic Church,
 and its teachings, and also for the
 purpose of erecting them on a Catholic Church
 have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and
 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
 release unto the Rt Rev M. P. Northrop D. D. Roman
 Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Charleston in
 the State aforesaid, and to his heirs and suc-
 cessors in office forever. All that Lot or parcel
 of land in the city of Spartanburg in the State
 of South Carolina on the East side of Dean Street,
 North of Main Street, beginning at a stone
 (on the North West corner of a new Street 60 feet
 wide, on the Dean Headstead) which is 482 $\frac{1}{2}$
 feet from the North East corner of main and
 Dean Streets) and running thence 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet north
 to a stone forming the North West corner of said
 lot (and the South West corner of the adjoining
 lot No 6); thence East 210 feet to a stone
 for the North East corner; thence South 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet
 to a stone on the new Street; thence 210 feet
 with said Street to beginning corner. They

 persons lawfully claiming, or to claim
