County of Spartanburg:  
Now all power by these presents,  
that C. B. Barnette, of State  
and County above named, for  
and in consideration of the

love and affection, which I bear towards Peggy  
Thornton, and her children, viz: Charles Thornton,  
Warren Thornton and Ada Thornton, and in the  
further consideration of the sum of \$100 dollars lawful  
money of the United States, to me in hand paid by the  
said Peggy Thornton, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
has granted bargained, sold and released,

conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do  
bargain sell, release, convey and confirm unto the said  
Peggy Thornton, for her natural life, then to her natural  
children, the said Charles Thornton, Warren Thornton  
and Ada Thornton, their heirs and assigns forever,  
all that tract or parcel of land wherein the said  
Peggy Thornton now resides, known as the "Fairfield"  
tract, lying and being in County and State aforesaid  
and bounded as follows: Beginning at a Stake  
on Gray's line (old) 144 chains from the South  
side of Pacolet river, in a course N 30 E  
thence N 45 W 22 chains 75 links to a pile of Pines  
in a field, thence N 30 E 18 chains 50 links to a  
Pin old corner of Poldis survey, thence N 15 1/2  
W 47 chains to a branch corner of Poldis survey  
thence with New Pettit's line to a Red Oak  
corner, thence N 17 E 2 chains 60 links to a  
Lightwood Stake, thence S. 72 E. 7 chains 13  
links to a Hickory corner of said survey, thence  
S 30 W 15 chains, no links, to a Stake in  
Henry Pettit's forked, thence S 30 W 5 chains 75  
links to the said Henry Pettit's Spring, thence  
branch with the meanders thereof 15 chains  
22 links to an old branch corner, on the left  
side of the branch, thence S. 58 W 6 chains 50  
links to a Hickory corner, thence a straight  
line to a Black Jack corner, thence S 18

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular on the said premises before mentioned unto the said Peggy Thornton, their natural life, and unto the said Charles Thornton, the said Varney Thornton, and the said Ada Thornton, their heirs and assigns, against myself, my heirs and assigns, and against any and all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
