have granted, bargained sold & released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the
said Elizabeth Caroline Stone (all of a certain
piece or parcel of land, being and lying in
Spartanburg County and State aforesaid, & joining
lands of Rochester Settler, Henry Ferguson, and
the estate of John Rhoads, deceased, beginning on a
stone, and running thence S 54° 10' 26.40" stake in
Gully, thence down the Gully S 69° to a stone, thence
N 42° 4' 15" stake in branch N 86° 1' 10' 1.79" to a Hickory S 88°
10' 2.28" Perimeter S 86° 1' 10' 11.35" down on creek S 83° 20' 40.5"
S. Gum S 81° 10' 1.56" to a Hickory, North 81° 10' 2.84" to
stake N 28° 1' E 4.38" to stake S 74° 1' S 6.25" to stake, thence N
13° 1' 10' 2.18" to stake N 85° 1' S 9.00" to stake N 30° 1' 27.25" to stone,
