Know all men by these presents,

 in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration
 of the sum of Ten thousand and eighty two Dollars
 and fifty cents to me paid by J. W. M. Eldred or
 second to be paid by said J. W. M. Eldred of the
 County of Spartanburg in the State aforesaid,
 have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and
 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
 release unto the said J. W. M. Eldred all the right,
 title, interest and claim that I have in the tract
 of Land belonging to the real estate of J. W. M. Eldred
 deceased situate in the said State and County and
 lying in branches of bases Creek, which interest
 consists of one child's share in said real estate
 which I held by a Deed from Mary A. Horton
 one of the children of said J. W. M. Eldred deceased -
 said tract bounded by lands of Mary Cantrell,
 Mahaly Kimbrell, Fielding Kimbrell and W. R.
 Horton, Beginning on our back branch on Mrs
 Mary Cantrell's line, & running eastward on
 said line to a stone; Thence, with certain lines
 agreed upon this day as division lines between
 the heirs of J. W. M. Eldred on one side and W. R.
 Horton on the other, S 3 1/2° W 20 chs to a stone;
 Thence S 37 1/2° W 70 chs to a stone on the W bank
 of a branch and at a bend; Thence up and
 with the meanders of the branch dited to the
 fork; Thence up and with the meanders of the
 left spring of said branch to Fielding Kimbrell's
 corner; Thence westward a straight line to a
 Hickory; Thence northward a straight line to a
 R. R.; Thence northward a straight line to a poplar
 near the mouth of our back branch; thence up said
 branch to the beginning, supposing to contain
 Eighty four and three fourths acres - more or less.
 Together with all and singular the rights,
 members, hindrances, and appurtenances to the
