Whereas all, now by these presents, that I, Daniel Humphries of the State of North Carolina, and Cleveland County, for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my son, W. O. Humphries, of the State of North Carolina, and County of Spartanburg, have given, granted, released and conveyed unto the said W. O. Humphries, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying, situate and being in the County of Spartanburg and State of North Carolina containing Two Hundred and Forty (240) acres, more or less, lying on Sarratt's creek, beginning on a Rock, on the State line, Francis Robinson's old original corner, at the edge of John Humphries old field, and running thence S. 66 chains to a small Post oak, thence N. 92 chains to a Sweet Gum, on the South side of Sarratt's creek, thence West five or six chains, more or less, to a stake, thence North East, to a Maple, on the South bank of the said creek, thence with, meanderings of the said creek, to a branch of Maples, just below the Wagon Ford, thence South west to a stake in Noble Sarratt's cotton patch, on the old original line, thence west to a Cyp. near the North side of Sarratt's creek, to a little Maple bottom, on Vernon Harris line, thence with said Harris line, to a Black Jack, Harris' corner, on the State line, thence East with the State line to the beginning; together with all and singular the rights, minerals, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining; do have and do give all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W.
