aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, released
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said Henry H. Turner, two
adjoining lots or parcels of land, lying and being
in the County and State aforesaid, situated on
the head branch of Cherokee creek, corners of
Pacolett river, adjoining lands of The Earles
R. C. Oliver, J. Van Chapman, and others. The
or larger tract, the following more
and bounds and measures, viz: Beginning on a
