Know all men by these presents, that I,

Milnor Jones (per Hilding Councill, Attorney

in fact under mortgage deed) of the County of Spartanburg,
in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of
Twenty five dollars to me paid by A. J. Abbot, of the County of
Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release, unto the said A. J. Abbot, all the following lot of land
lying in the corporate limits of the City of Spartanburg, in said
State, being South of Henry street, and of Limestone branch,
it being a portion of the lands formerly owned by said Milnor
Jones, and is fully set forth in a plat of said lands made by
R. O. Sims, Surveyor, and to which reference is hereby made. The
lot hereby sold is the following to wit: Lot No. 7, beginning at
a stake on Henry street, and running S. 21° E. 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ feet to a stake then
on Alley, thence with said Alley, N. 68° E. 66 $\frac{3}{8}$ feet to a stake then
N. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ feet to a stake on Henry street, thence with Henry
street S. 168 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 66 $\frac{3}{8}$ feet to the beginning corner, and containing
Twenty eight one hundredths of an acre, more or less, all of which
will, and fully appear by a reference to said plat, which is annexed
to a deed of this date, made by said Milnor Jones (per his said
Attorney in fact), to H. C. Bollman. Together with all and singular
the rights, members, appendages and appurtenances to the said
