Wimard of the County of Abbeville, in the State aforesaid for and consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and foy hundred dollars, to me paid by James Heribitt Tucker of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said James Heribitt Tucker, all that tract of land lying and being in the County of Spartanburg and State of South Carolina, and bounded on the North by lands belonging to Ada M. Tucker and James Heribitt Tucker and Mrs Williamson, on the East by lands of Fred and Samuel Jones and Robt Wimard, now, on the South by lands of M. H. Rogers and estate of Willis Littlefield, and on the West by lands belonging to myself containing three hundred and twelve acres more or less, being one half of the land allotted to James Heribitt Tucker and myself in the last will and testament of my grandfather Samuel M. Tucker, now of record in the office of the Probate Judge for the County of Spartanburg, and State of South Carolina. No deed to the other half of said lands having been made to me by James Heribitt Tucker, for the same consideration, and of these date, etc. these presents. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Heribitt Tucker, his heirs and assigns forever. And to do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors & administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Heribitt Tucker, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
