Nota Procrates Lease
That Procrates, State of South Carolina
County of Spartanburg
Agreement of Lease made
this 20th day of October 1883 Between Roda & Procrates
first part and Thomas Procrates of second.
Witnesseth that the said Thomas Procrates agrees
to pay to Roda & Procrates three hundred and
thirty dollars for five years for the rent
of the lands lying on waters of Ocalah and
Richland Creek. The lease to commence on the
first day of January 1884 and continue
until the first day of January 1888. Thomas
to be paid in December in each year to Roda
& Procrates at J. J. Lipscomb. A failure to pay
the rent as agreed or to comply with any of the
stipulations of this lease the Procrates shall
authorize the said Roda & Procrates to consider
the same forfeited; and she may take possession
of premises without notice and without process.
