This deed made by J. J. Magness, to Ellison Gray, Thomas McNamee, Jack Jones, J R Ellis, and A L Robbs, trustees of, Grassy Pond Baptist Church. Witnesseth, That the said J J Magness, has, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents, doth bargain, sell and convey to the said Ellison Gray, Thomas McNamee, Jack Jones, J R Ellis, and A L Robbs, trustees aforesaid, for and in consideration of One dollar (\$1.) to the said J J Magness, paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the following tract, piece or parcel, of land, lying in the County of Spartanburg, and State of South Carolina, and bounded as follows, Beginning on a rock on the Bonnet road, and running S<sup>o</sup> 2<sup>o</sup> E. one 1/2 chain, 51 1/2 links, to a rock, thence S 89 1/2 W. 6 chains, 50 links, to a rock, thence E 89 1/2 N. 6 chains, 51 1/2 links, to a rock on said road, thence with said road, S 89 1/2 E. 6 chains, 50 links, to a rock at the place of beginning, and containing one 1/2 acre more or less. To have and to hold such tract or parcel of land, to the said Ellison Gray, Thomas McNamee, Jack

Jones, J R Ellis, and A L Robbs trustees as aforesaid  
and to their successors in office, for so long a time
