This deed made by J. J. Magness, to Edison Clary, Thomas McGraw, Jack Jones, J. R. Ellis, and A. L. Robb, deacons, or trustees of Grassy Pond Baptist Church. Witnesseth, that the said J. J. Magness, has, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents, doth bargain, sell, and convey to the said Edison Clary, Thomas McGraw, Jack Jones, J. R. Ellis, and A. L. Robb, trustees aforesaid, for and in consideration of One dollar (\$1.00) to the said J. J. Magness, paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the following tract, piece or parcel, of land, lying in the county of Spartanburg, and State of South Carolina, and bounded as follows, Beginning on a rack on the Bonnet road, and running South 2° E. on 1/2 chain, 51 2/3 links, to a rack; thence S 89 1/2° W. 6 chains, 50 links, to a rack; thence S 89 1/2° W. 51 2/3 links, to a rack on said road; thence with said road, S 89 1/2° E. 6 chains, 50 links, to a rack, at the place of beginning, and containing one acre more or less. To have and to hold such tract or parcel of land, to the said Edison Clary, Thomas McGraw, Jack

Jones, J A Ellis, and A L Robbs trustees as aforesaid
 and to their successors in office, for so long a time
 as said property, or land, shall be used by said trustees
