Alfred C. Timmons. State of South Carolina:
Know all men by these presents,
That I, Isham A. Mayfield,
of Lyncroft, in the County of Greenville, in the State
aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of
One thousand dollars, to me paid by Alfred C.
Timmons of Spartanburg County, in the State
aforesaid, I have granted, bargained, sold and
released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said Alfred C. Timmons, all
that piece, parcel or tract of land, situated, lying
and being in the County of Spartanburg, etc., being
a male portion say about 3½ acres, which lay in the
County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, this being the
same land, as deeded to my father Abraham J. Mayfield
by Abraham Mayfield, on the twenty third of August,
1859, I being the only and sole heir of Isham J.
Mayfield, and having become in possession and
owner of said land by his last will and testament
the said tract of land as surveyed by James W. Dickson
March 26, 1861, and, now as follows: Beginning
at a Post Oak 31 on the bank of South Tyger river,
