 granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
 presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the
 said Emanuel George, all that plantation or tract
 of land, situated in said County, on the Old
 bridge branch, waters of Pacolet river, bounded by
 lands of Ely Hovatt and Archibald Kennedy, and
 others, containing Sixty acres, beginning on a
 Porcupine, on the old Green river road, it running

 the line to a W O Stump of Common corner, thence S
