McKittrick, a certain tract or parcel of land situate, in the State aforesaid, and lying between the waters of Sassafras river and South Tigger, beginning at an Iron Spike on Greenville and Spartanburg line, running thence S 78 E 15.30 to a Forward 37 thence N 12 E 2.81 to an Iron Spike 37 thence N 86 1/2 E 4.38 to a Pine 37, thence N 78 E 19.75 to an Iron Spike by Branch, thence N 65 3/4 W 36.00 to a Pine on Greenville and Spartanburg line, thence S 1 1/4 W 17.00 to beginning Iron Spike, containing Thirty six acres more or less, and bounded on North by Mary Duncan, and East by Mary Duncan, and South by E. D. McKittrick and West by Davis Coan.
