P. Bobo 25th November, 1882. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Spencer Mills, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Spencer Mills, his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, and all other persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

Know all men by these presents that I, E. P. Little, of Washington, D. C., for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to me paid by W. R. Lipscomb, of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. R. Lipscomb all that parcel or lot of land lying in Gaffney City, State and County aforesaid, and beginning on a stake on line of Victoria Avenue, thence S. 32° E., four hundred feet to stake on line of said Avenue; thence N. 68° E., 9.03 chs to stake; thence S. 55½° E., 1.71½ chs to stake in branch; thence N. 34½° E., 1.36½ chs to stake on line with Lipscomb Street; thence along Lipscomb Street N. 55½° W., to a point on Lipscomb Street, through which point a straight line drawn at right angle with Victoria Avenue, and commencing at the point of beginning stake would pass, thence to beginning, containing six acres, more or less.
