aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released,
and by these presents, do grant bargain, sell and
release unto the said Georgia Ray all of our
interest in that tract of land beginning on
Mazant road running thence 33 S. W. 9.50 to Stone-
thence (degrees not given) to Stone near Colevill house
thence to Black oak in Mazant road thence with
said road to beginning corner containing 6 1/2
acres more or less, and bounded by lands of Dr
O. L. Moore, O. B. Deuch & Henry Colevill. Together with
all and singular the rights, members, benefits and
appurtenances to the premises belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining; To have
and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Georgia Ray her

ourselves, and heirs & executors and Administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Georgia Ray her

all that Lot or parcel of land situated in the
City of Spartanburg in aforesaid County and
State on South Church Street, fronting on said street
sixty six (66) feet - Bounded on the north by lot formerly
owned by Mr. S. McManis and now owned by Schmidt
and Becker on South by lot of J. C. & J. B. Cleveland
on the East by said Church Street and on the West
