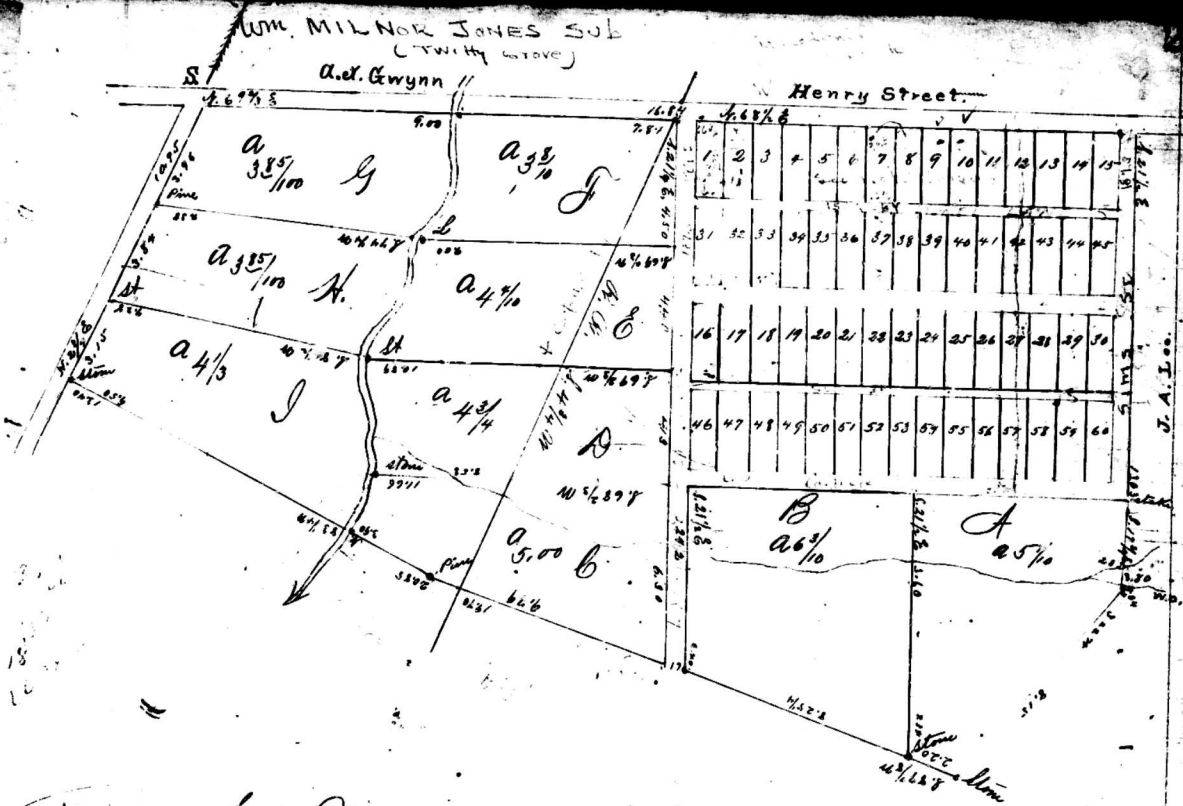

Know all men by these presents that B. A. Reid, of the State aforesaid, County of Spartanburg, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to him

Nathan Moore, in the State aforesaid, County of Spartanburg, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by this presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Nathan Moore a certain lot or parcel of land, situated on Broad Branch, waters of Shickety Creek, on the southwest side of said Creek, beginning and running as follows: On a stone 3 x 0, John S. Wilkins and Garrison's corner; thence with Wilkins line, S. 4 W., 25.50 to a stone x 3, another of said Wilkins' corner; thence S. 87 1/2 E., 7.10 to pine 3 x 0 on Isaac McComson's line, another of Wilkins' corner; thence with McComson's line N. 8 1/2 W., 10.70 to P. O., 111 x 0 corner for this and McComson's land; thence S. 87 1/2 E., 12.40 to Persimmon 111 x m on a small branch; thence down the meanderings of said branch to a junction with Broad Branch; thence up the meanderings of said Broad Branch to the mouth of a small branch, coming in from Southwest; thence up the said branch to white Oak 111 x m at the head of said branch; thence S. 36 W., 7.80 to the beginning, containing Seventy-eight acres, more or less.
