Reynolds, of the County of Spartanburg, in the State of North Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen hundred dollars, to me paid by John Wheeler of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Wheeler, all that certain portion, parcel or tract of land, situated, lying and being in the aforesaid State and County, on Middle Syger river, and bounded by Land of Marley Smith, Robert Smith, James Herbert, estate of John Barker, and by said Middle Syger river, beginning at a stake on said river, and running thence N 18 E 16.57 to a stone 3x thence N 20 W 85.90 to a Black Oak 3x 3x; thence S 77 1/2 W 21.50 to a stone 3x, thence S. 52 W 15.25 to a stone near a Dogwood, thence N 46 W 12.10 to a Post Oak, thence N 44 W 22.10 to a stake, near a Pine, thence S. 39 W 23.10 to a stone 3x 3x; thence down the said Middle Syger river, with the meandering of the same to the beginning corner, containing Two hundred and Ninety acres, more or less, all of which is more fully shown by Plat of said land, made by J. M. Wood, March 3, 1874. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
