Know all men by these presents that J. K. Robison, of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred and Sixty-four Dollars to me paid by John Wheeler and T. W. Wingo both of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Wheeler and T. W. Wingo all that certain portion, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, on the South side of the South Fork of Syger River, Beginning at a stake at the Abbe Bridge and running thence with the Greenville public road in the direction of Greenville, 25.88; thence S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.70 to a stone, 3 $\times$; thence S. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.17 to a stone, 3 $\times$; thence N. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.46 to a stake in said Greenville road; thence West with the road 6.65 to a Red Oak, 3 $\times$; thence N. 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 31.40 to a stone, 3 $\times$ Wingo's Corner; thence N. 28 E. 7.70 to a Birch, 3 $\times$ a.m., on said River; thence with the meanderings of the River to the beginning corner, at said Abbe Bridge, containing Ninety-seven acres, be the same more or less, all of which is more fully shown on a plat of the same made by J. S. Williamson, Surveyor for myself bearing date with this deed. Together with all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Wheeler and T. W. Wingo, their heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Wheeler and T. W. Wingo, their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, or any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
