Harris, of Spartanburg County, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H.R. Harris, all my interest in my father's real estate, being a lot or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and on both sides of Ashworth Creek, waters of Broad River, and known as Lot No 2 in the division of the real estate of Henry Ruppe, deceased, joining lands on the South belonging to Ross Bay: On the North by the State line; on the East by John Ruppe, and on the west by heirs of W.B. Godfrey, and more fully described by plat made by H. Paris, Surveyor, containing \_\_\_\_\_ acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular the premises before mentioned rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, on in anywise incident or appertaining. The same being subject to my father's (Henry Ruppe, deceased), last Will.

I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said H.R. Harris, his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H.R. Harris, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and all other persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
