Know all men by these presents that I, Fannie J. Forde, wife of F. H. Forde, now residing in the City of Columbia, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars to me paid by Charles Thompson, of the town of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles Thompson all that lot or parcel of land lying and being in the town of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, on the west side of the big branch, known as the Van Gard branch, lying on the north side of main street leading from the Court House to Anderson's Mill, being the south half of the lot purchased by A. C. Simmons and T. H. Ford, of John Giddes the 23^d day of October, AD 1878, and more particularly known as the R. C. Poole lot. Beginning at a stone on the forks of the road, or street, where the street runs across the street known as the old Greenville Road, or street, and runs N. 65 E., along the main street to a stone corner; thence N. 30 W., 2 chains 25 links to mid or half way of the aforesaid lot to a stone or corner; thence N. 65 W., 4 chains 50 links through center of aforesaid lot to
