Wingo both of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Wheeler and T. W. Wingo all that certain portion, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, on the South side of the South Fork of Tyger River, Beginning at a stake at the Abie Bridge and running thence with the Greenville public road in the direction of Greenville, 35.88; thence S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., 1.70 to a stone, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence S. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., 3.17 to a stone, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., 1.46 to a stake in said Greenville road; thence West with the road 6.65 to a Red Oak, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence N. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., 31.40 to a stone, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ Wingo's corner; thence N. 28 E., 7.70 to a Birch, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ o.m., on said River; thence with the meanderings of the River to the beginning corner, at said Abie Bridge, containing Ninety-seven acres, be the same more or less, all of which is more fully shown on a Plat of the same made by J.S.
