of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid,
have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said J. H. Blauningame, one certain lot or
parcel of land containing five tenths of an acre
more or less, situated in the City of Spartanburg,
and having the following lines and bounds, to wit:
Beginning on a Rock on Liberty Street, from N 55 $\frac{1}{2}$
E 3.25 to a Rock, thence South 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 2.88 to a Rock on
Herring Street, thence South 67 W 3.17 with said street
to a Rock on Liberty Street, thence North 16 W 2.23
with Liberty street, to the beginning corner. Said
lot is fully described and known by what made by
W. S. Sams, Surveyor, on the 26th of July, 1879, which
said plat is to this deed attached, and bounded by
lots of No. 16 Thompson on the North, and lot of
Walker & Blauningame on the East, and lots North
of the St. M. R.R. tracks. Together with all and
belonging to the right, privilege, hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or

Greenwood, Loccus and Sparta burg Railroad Company
in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained, sold & released
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
the said Greenwood, Loccus and Sparta burg Railroad
Company all that lot or parcels of land lying being
in the City of Sparta burg, in the County and State
aforesaid, beginning at the Southeast corner of
said lot, running thence N 21° 10' 20" go with New Mayfield
