Know all men by these  
present, That I Willis Smith of the County  
of Spartanburg in the State aforesaid, for  
and in consideration of the sum of Six  
Hundred Twenty one and Twenty five cents  
Dollars to me paid by R. M. Smith of the  
County of Spartanburg in the State aforesaid,  
have granted, bargained, sold, and released,  
and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
sell and release unto the said R. M. Smith  
all that tract or parcel of land situated  
lying and being in the County and State  
aforesaid, on both sides of the Georgia Road  
being a part of the Amas Ray tract beginning  
on a Spanish Oak 3x near Poole's branch Bay  
creek, thence S 12 W 43° to a small Hickory  
3x; thence S 66 W 36.40 to a Stake 3x; thence  
S 30 E 8.50 R. O. dead 3x; thence S 73 E 22.00 to  
a stake 3x; thence S 50 E 20.50 to the beginning  
point, containing in these bounds seventy  
one acres more or less. Together with all  
and singular the rights, members, hereditaments  
and appurtenances to the said premises be-  
longing, or in anywise incident, or ap-  
pertaining; To have and to hold all and
