Brock, of the County and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. A. Brock, all those tracts or parcels of land, lying and being in Spartanburg County, and State aforesaid in branches of Bird creek, waters of South Piedmont river, adjoining lands belonging to H. C. Beaulieu, C. C. Beaulieu, J. M. Finch, and others, beginning on a Pine, near fork of road to J. M. Finch's, running thence N 76 W 20.25 to a Rock, thence N 16 E 20.00 chains to a stake, not set up in original line, thence along said line N 58 E 22.00 chains to a double landmark on side of road, that runs from Compton's bridge to Howard Gap road, thence intersects about two miles above Bowman Station thence along said road to the beginning Pine corner, containing forty five acres, more or less. Also another tract or parcel of land adjoining the above described tract, beginning at a Post Oak and running thence S 87 W 25.00 chains to a double pine, thence S 40.75 E 50 chains to a Pine Knot, thence N 78 E about 26.00 chains to the beginning corner, containing fifteen and one half acres, more or less, being a piece of land, sold by B.
