Know all men by these presents, that I, Jackson B. Stone, of the County of Spartanburg and State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand dollars, to me paid in hand by N. A. Brock, of the County and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. A. Brock, all three tracts or parcels of land, lying and being in Spartanburg County, and State aforesaid in branches of Bird creek, waters of South Piedmont river, adjoining lands belonging to A. C. Russell, C. Cantrell, J. M. Finch, and others, beginning on a Pine, near fork of road to J. M. Finch's, running thence N 76 W 20.25 to a Rock, thence N 16 W 20.00 chains to a stake, not set up in original line, thence along said line N 58 W 22.00 chains to a double landmark on side of road, that runs from Cooper's bridge to Howard's Gap road, thence intersects about two miles above Bowman Station thence along said road to the Beginning Pine corner, containing forty five acres, more or less. Also another tract or parcel of land adjoining the above described tract, beginning at a Post Oak, and running thence S 87 W 25.00 chains to a double pine, thence S 40 W 50 chains to a Pine Knot, thence N 78 E about 20.00 cts to the beginning corner, containing fifteen and one half acres, more or less, being a piece of land, sold by B. B. Brock, of Jackson Co. Stone (myself). Together with all and singular the rights, liberties, conditions and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining: Do have used to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said N. A. Brock, his heirs and assigns forever; and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said N. A. Brock his heirs and assigns, against myself, my heirs and assigns, and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.  paid by Edward C. Logan of the County of
 Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid, have granted,
 bargained, sold and released and by these parties
 do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
 Edward C. Logan, all that certain portion, parcel
 or tract of land, situated, lying and being in the
 County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, on
 Jernin's creek, waters of North Inger creek, bearing the
 following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to
 wit: Beginning at a stone 7.00, and thence running
 N 66¹/₄ E 21.10 to a stone 3x 2.00 (by a Post oak 3x 1.00)
 thence S 38¹/₄ W 16.25 to Jernin's creek, thence with
 the creek, about 11.00 to a small Black Gum (in the
 creek) 3x 0.00, and thence S 1/4 E 20.27 to the beginning
 corner, bounded by lands of Samuel Pullinger,
