Turner, all and singular, his and interest, the same being in remainder in and to all that certain piece or parcel of land, situated and being on the South side of Lenoir's Fork creek in the County of Spartanburg, and State aforesaid, beginning at a Poplar on South side of said creek, thence S. 27.95. to Rock pile in red field, thence S. 17. E. 12.45 chs to a Post Oak down, thence S. 28. 10 25.20 chs to a Black Oak, thence S. 5. 10 22.40 chs to a Pine and Dogwood, thence N. 69. 10 26.75 chs to a Turkey Oak, down N. 34. 1/2 E. 25.15 to a Black oak, down thence S. 22. 7 11.70 chain to a small Post Oak N. 45. E. 6.30 chs to a Rock in the field N. 45. 1/2 E. 23.57 chs to a dead White Oak, thence N. 43. 10 13 chs to a Black Oak, thence N. 40. 10 13.17 chs to a White Oak, thence N. 40.
