Love and affection & care for the said Sarah S.
Williams of Spartanburg City in the State
aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
sell and release unto the said Sarah S. Williams
all that Lot or parcel of land situated in the
City of Spartanburg in aforesaid County and
State on South Church Street, fronting on said street
Sixty Six (66) feet - Bounded on the north by lot formerly
owned by W. S. McElroy and now owned by Schmidt
and Beckel on south by lot of J. C. & J. B. Cleveland
on the East by said church street and on the West
