State of South Carolina:

Whereas Petey McDowell, Matthew West, and others, on or about the 2<sup>d</sup>

day of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, did exhibit their petition in the Court of Probate, at Spartanburg, County House, setting forth that David W. McDowell, deceased, left his estate, on or about the day of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, seized and possessed in fee of a certain plantation or tract of land, containing Two hundred and Sixty acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Jas. McDowell, W. Young, J. A. McDowell, and others, and Lot No 2, adjoining lands of B. Hall, Jr. McDowell, and Lot No 1, that partition and division of said lands, yet remained to be made which they prayed might be done: And whereas afterwards, to wit, on the eleventh day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, Beuy Wofford, Esq. Probate Judge of Spartanburg County, after due examination and order and decree, that the land described in the said petition be sold by the Sheriff of Spartanburg on the first Monday in January the next ensuing, or on such other sale day, as would be most for the advantage of the parties in interest, or as credit could be given, with interest from date. And whereas John Deberry, as Sheriff of the County aforesaid, after having duly advertised the said tract of land for sale by public outcry, on the fifth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, did then openly and publicly, and according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the tract of land before mentioned unto Wm. E. McDowell, for the sum of Four hundred forty dollars, the being, at that price, the last and highest bid for the same. And therefore, Wm. E. McDowell by these presents, that I, Beuy Wofford, Esq. Probate Judge, as aforesaid, under and by virtue of the decree of the Probate Judge, aforesaid, and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars, and forty dollars, received to be paid to the Probate Judge aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. E. McDowell, all that certain piece, parcel & plantation of land, containing Two hundred and Sixty acres more or less, Lot No 3, adjoining lands of James McDowell, W. Young, J. A. McDowell, and others, containing Sixty six acres, more or less. Lot No 2, adjoining lands of B. Hall, Jr. McDowell, and Lot No 1, and containing one hundred acres, Ninety four (194) acres, more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, incidents, & appurtenances belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining

to the said processes, and also of the estate, right, title, interest, claim, processes, property, claim & demands whatsoever, either at law or in equity of the said and representatives of the said David McDowell, deceased, and of the parties to this suit or any other person, right, title, claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by force or under them or either of them: To have and to hold the said the said tract of land with its appurtenances, hereditaments and all privileges unto the said W. C. McDowell, his heirs and assigns, to him, and their posterity, and benefit forever. In witness whereof, I, the said Beij H. Wofford, Esq., Probate Judge of the County aforesaid, render and by virtue of the said order and decree have executed this my hand and seal, this 28<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, and the Ninety-fifth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
