Bush, of the County of Spartanburg, in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. J. Bush, all that tract of land, known as the Mill tract beginning on a Post Oak, on Mill road, N.W. corner and running N 60° W 20.65 to stone, thence E 15° S 16.50 to Dogwood on creek, thence two E 6.29 to stone, thence corner, thence S 60° E 30.40 to double Ash, Camp's corner, thence S 32° E 14.30 to ditch, thence up ditch to Poplar stump, thence S 34° E 30.50 to beginning, containing Seventy-eight acres more or less, bounded by lands of W.W.
