Whereas on the twenty
ninth day of January 1875 Harvey Wafford
now deceased, made an agreement of which
the following is a copy to wit "Jan 29th 1875.
This is to certify that Jeremiah Wafford did this
day give me a note for one hundred & eighteen
dollars & nineteen cents due one day after date
I agree on the final payment of \$5 to relinquish
all my right & title to the place he now lives
on to R. L Wafford or to any of his heirs as he
may elect & Wafford" and whereas the said
note has been paid this day in full by R. L
Wafford, and whereas the heirs of the said
Jeremiah Wafford, who is now deceased,
have waived their rights to the said land, and
requesting us to make this deed to their mother,
the said R. L Wafford. Now I give all my
by these presents that we Joseph L Wafford,
John M Wafford, and Benjamin Wafford,
executors of the last will and testament of
the said Harvey Wafford, deceased, as such
executors, and by virtue of our office as Ex-
ecutors of his said last will & testament
have granted, bargained, sold, and released,
and by these presents do grant, bargain,
sell and release unto the said R. L Wafford,

all that tract of land on which the said deceased A. L. Wofford lived at the time the said note was made to him, bounded by lands of Benjamin Wofford, S. W. Stradith, John Henderson, and Estate of Thomas Rogers, deceased, and containing one hundred and forty nine acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, moneys, chattel, tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said A. L. Wofford his heirs, and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves and heirs executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. L. Wofford his heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

Witness our hands and seal this thirtieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three and in the one hundred and 8th year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America.
