 dollars, to me paid by J. W. Jones, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, in the State
 aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
 sell and release unto the said J. W. Jones, a certain
 lot or parcel of land lying and being in the
 corporate limits of the Village of Woodruff, on the
 East side of Main street, beginning at a stone 38 on
 said Main street, running thence to a stone 38;
 to G. W. H. Stone 38, thence with said G. W. H. to stone
 38 on Main street, thence with said Main street to
 beginning, stone corner, containing two acres, more or
 less, and bounded on the West by Main street, on the
 South & East by lands of A. B. Woodruff. Together
 with all and singular the rights, incumbrances, claims,
 demands and appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging or in anywise incident or pertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said J. W. Jones his heirs and
 assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my
 heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant & forever
 defend all and singular the said premises unto
