Betsey Brance and Jane, all which property as above mentioned
to be equally divided between my seven children to the forever
except such as is hereinafter mentioned. Item I give to my son
in law William Barton five Shillings Item I give to my son in law
Thos Smith five Shillings Item I give to the heirs of my son
William Smith five Shillings and I do nominate, constitute & ap-
point my two sons Charles and Nelson Smith executors of this my
last will and Testament. And do declare this to be my last will

have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventeenth day of April
Eighteen hundred and fifteen, Witness sealed and published by the
above named Edward Smith as and for his last will and Testament
in the presence of us who at his request and in his presence
