Also one third part of my houshold And Kitchen furniture Except one wellnut cubboard to James which is not to be his untill my wifes Death also one third part of my farming tools to my wife. 2nd I bequeath to my sons James & William all my land forever at my Wifes Death to be equally Divided & that James have prefer-If however either or both of them Should think proper to live on the plantation prior to the Death of my Wife they the liberty so to do with all the houses out houses /except what has already been named. To my Sons James & William I bequeath one Still & Vefsels alfo my waggon & its appendons.

I bequeath to my daughter Hannah Ten Dollar towards buycing a saddle A bridle cow & calf bedetimented and furnithms It is my will that all the Remainder of my stock of what ever kind be kept on the plantation for the ufe of the family while they live together; but thankd any of them remove they shall have their part I mean an equal part delivered them 6th A is my will that my Executors shall divide all my books equilly between my wife Ann my some James & William Mary Finley & Roman McCarter 7th It is my will that a bale of Cotton which is now packed be sold & after carrage be paid the price equally Divided between my Wife Ann My Daughters Mary Finley & Hannah Eccorter

Sth It is my will that a bale of Cotton which is now packed be sold & after carrage be paid its price equally Divided between my Wife Ann My Daughters Mary Finley & Hannah McCorter Sth. I bequeath all my Cash, bonds, notes and book accounts between my sons James & William Sofanna Thompson Elegabeth Cunningham Mary Finley and Hannah McCorter equally, after my funer-
