ISHAM FOSTER

In the Name God Amen, I. Isham Foster of the State of South Carolina of the District of Spartanburgh planter Being in a low health State of but Sound in memory, Cawling to mind the Shortners of the life of men I think proper to make this my last will and-- testament in manner following, that is to say, I give into the hands of God who gave it, and my body to the Earth from whence it came to be buried in a Christian Decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors after named, and to my worldly goods it hath pleased God of his Infinite goodness to Indow me with, I depose of them as follo eth, first in premases I lend to my loving wife Polley Foster one Negro man named Thrim also one Negro--woman Named Jane, also the plantation whereon I now live, also two Cows & Calves four head of sheep ten head of hogs one horse all the household ferneture during her life, and after her death, and ~~that out of~~ that Estate to be Equally divided amongst all my Children Except the land which is for David Foster I give and bequeath to my Son David Foster one Negro boy named John the tract of land one bed and ferneture Cow and Calf one Sow and pigs to him and his heirs for Ever, I give and bequeath to Daughter Belilah one Negro man Named Reuben also one horse, bed and ferneture one Cow and Calf, Sow and pigs to her and heirs for Ever, also I give and bequeath to my Grand Son Asalom Foster one hundred Dollars to be paid to him when he becomes of Age to be paid by my Son David he taking the same out of the Estate for that purpose, I give and bequeath to Daughter Arnen Hawkins one Negro woman Named Etsey to her and her heirs for ever which she has now in hand, I give and bequeath to my Son Robert Foster, Patsey Brown, Nancy Foster & Polley Traylor Each five Shillings as they have had what I thought writt, Lastly I appoint my Son Robert Foster and my Son David Foster Executors to this my last will and testament, revoking Ev ry form of the Same hetherto, having or had, been made, In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this fifth day of

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August in the ^{year} of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Six-
