will and Testament in manner following—

my Just Debts to be paid—I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Son Joel a 1 the tract of land that I now live on, but if my Son
Joel dies without a Lawful Heir, my will is that Said land be
Equally divided amongst all my brothers and Sisters Except Prady
Headline to have fifty dollars worth over and above an equal Share—
I give and bequeath unto my Beloved wife my Negro Molly and all
her inc since I also bequeath unto her the ~~contents~~ of all live
stock of every kind, also two beds, all the other Household
furniture & farming utensils to be Equally divided between Said
Wife and Son my will is that my wife keeps possession of the house
and as much of the land as She will incline to work
Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my brother in law John
Clark & Son Joel Executors and wife Francis Executrix to this my
last will and Testament -----
