Carolina and District of Spartanburgh, being weak in body, but of sound ~~in~~ memory, (Blessed be God) do this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & Eight, Make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following (that is to say)-----

First. I give & bequeath to my son Isaac Wofford one Negroe man named Cyrus ----

I also give & bequeath to my son William Wofford two Tracks of land, one of thirtysix acres taken up by myself, the other two hundred & forty more or less, purchas<sup>d</sup> by myself from Joseph Lannon, one Negroe woman named Lempy all my stock of cattle hogs & sheep, farming tools Household Furniture, with this injuntion that he take care of his Mother & provide for her, her life time-----

and in respect of the rest of my children, I have given them and each of them, (in my life time) what I design<sup>d</sup> to give them,-----

and lastly I do make and constitute, my wele Beloved Son William Wofford, & my trusty Friend Willie Williford Executors to this my last will & testament, in witnefs whereof I the said John Wofford sen<sup>r</sup> have, hereunto set my hand and seal, the day & year above written-----
