infinity goodness to inow me with I dispose of them as fol oweth---
In prmes I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Polly Lewis the
tract of land and plantation where on I now live I do give and
bequeath unto my loving wife Polly Lewis six Negroes named as
fo ows George Dick Winn banner Jefferson and Harry to gether with
all of my house hold and kitchen furniture and stock with the
exception of ten Cows and Calves an two good horsee saddles and
bridles, reserving her natural inheritance and property with the above
tract of land negroes house hold and kitchen furniture and stock
of all kin to be equally deviced between my two children to wit
Frances and John Lewis to them and their heirs forever. I also
give and bequeath unto my loving daughter Frances Lewis The
Plantatio or brach of land I purchased of David Lewis also thirty
acres part of the tract That I purchase from E - Hutcheson; Also
Ten Negroes Named as Vis) Frank an Susannah; Cathay; Balender;
Illey; Charlett; Jack; Robert; James; Seeley, Also Five Cows
and Calves and Likely horse Saddle & Bridle; One Feather Bed
and furniture; Also Five Hundred Dollars To Come Intrest from
the presents late to her before and aignal for ever.

I Also Give And bequeath unto my son John Lewis The plantation
or Tract of land I purchased from James Lewis and Also Sixty Acres
of land that lie between the mill and Weatherford on the 5th
Aice of the Creek: And I Also Two Hundred Acres of land that I
Purchased from John Couch; Also Ten Negroes Vis) Peter; Binthy;
Neoma; sto; Spense; Jerry; Henry; George; Horice; Gini: Together
Five Cows & Calves One Likely Horse Saddle & Bridle, One Feather

and bequeath unto my Children Frances an^d John Lewis Fifty
Dollars Extroney Yearly from the present Date to Dispsoe of as
they See Cause Untill they become of Age: I give and Bequeath
unto all my Children all of My estate to be Divided among them
as above mentioned After my Death; And Lastly I appoint I Apoint
John Chapman Esq And Polly Lewis Executor of this my last Will
And Testament hereby Revoking and disannulling all and every former
Wills heretofore made and Declared What is Contained in this my
last will and Legal Testament in Witness Whereof I have set my
hand And Seal this 14 Day of January ,1815.
