of man I have thought proper to make this my last will and test-men-
-----in manner and form fol owing that is to say my soul I give into
the hands of almighty god and my body to the earth to be buried in
a decent christian manner at the discretion of my executors after
name, and as to my worldly goods if hath pleased almighty god of his
infinity goodness to inow me with I dispose of them as fol oweth---
In primes I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Polly Lewis the
tract of land and plantation where on I now live I do give no
bequeath unto my loving wife Polly Lewis six Negroes named as
fo own- George Dick Winnanner Jefferson and Mary together with
all of my house hold and kitchen furniture and stock with the
exception of ten Cows and Calves and two good horses saddles and
bridles, during her natural life and after her death the above
tract of land negroes house hold and kitchen furniture and stock
of all kind to be equally divided between my two children to wit
frances and John lives to them and their heirs forever. I also
give and bequeath unto my loving daughter Frances Lewis The
plantation or brach of land I purchest of david Lewis also thirty
acres part of the tract That I purchase from M^r Butcheson; Also
Ten Negroes Named as Vis) Frank and Susannah; Cathay; Balender;
Willey; Charlett; Jack; Robert; James; Sealey, Also Five Cows
and Calves and Likely horse Saddle & Bridle; One Feather Bed
and furniture; Also Five Hundred Dollars To Carry Interest from
the presents date to her heirs and assigns for ever---
I Also Give and bequeath unto my son John Lewis The plantation
or Tract of land I purchased from James Lewis and Also Sixty Acres
of land that Lie between the mill and - weatherford on the south
side of the creek; And I Also Two Hundred Acres of land that I
Purchased from John Couch; Also Ten Negroes Vis) Peter; Sinthy;
Meoma; Cato; Spensio; Jerry; Henry; George; Morice; Gin; Together
Five Cows & Calves One likely Horse Saddle - Bridle, One Feather
bed and furniture; And Five Hundred Dollars To Carry Interest from

and bequesth unto my Children Frances and John Lewis Fifty Dollars Extroney Yearly from the present Date to Dispsce of as they See Cause Untill they become of Age: I give and Bequesth unto all my Children all of My estate to be Divided among them as above mentioned After my Death; And Lastly I apoint I Apoint John Chapman Esq And Polly Lewis Executor of this my last Will And Testament hereby Revokeing and disanuling all and every former Wills heretofore made and Declared what is Contained in this my last Will and Legal Testament in Witnes Whereof I have set my hand And Seal this 14 Day of January, 1815.
