in writing being annexed and doth alienate. I do confirm and by these
 words do give of right bargain sell alien and convey unto the said Isaac et
 Francis his heirs and assigns forever all that tract here or parcel of land
 above lying and being in the County of Antrim and State of North
 Carolina on the waters of Ball's Creek joining lands of Brown & the Wilson
 and others beginning at a stake a corner of the Division line and running
 thence N.E. 1/4 of a mile to a Hickory tree west of the south 100 poles
 thence E. 1/4 S. 1/4 of a mile to the beginning containing 25 acres be the same
 or less being part of a tract of land originally granted by the State to
 James Hamilton date the 16th Nov 1790 and confirmed by him to
 George Parish the 6th Feb'y 1802 and from him to Charles Edward Wilson
 Jr. Walker 4th Decr 1838 from him to Abeslon Hale 16th Oct 1834
 from him to the said Reuben Perkins 2^d Janurary 1836. As well more
 as appear on Record together with all woods ways waters and water
 rights and all and every other appurtenance therewith belonging or in any
 way claiming and he redissen and reversion remaining remainder and
 all dues rents issues and profits of the aforesaid lands and premises
 and every part thereof and see the Estate right little Interest claim
