Polly - John, Nancy, - Betsy and Sally I Give five hundred Dollars to be Equally Devided Amongst them - All the Residue and Remainder of my Estate and Effect of what natur or kind soever, I will that my Executors do sell at twelve months Credit and Equally Devide the A^m of such sale, in manner following amongst my Children & Grand Children - whose Names Are Under written - my son William Wiledar - my son Spenceer Bobo - my son Baram - my son Absolum - my son Chaney - my son Hiram - my son Jeremiah my son Willis - my Daughter Lexina - my Daughter Polley - my Daughter Betsy - my five Grand Children Above Nam'd to have one part amongst them - and my Daughter Nancy, two Children (Viz.) sally Rachell and samuel simpson Each to have a part - and I do Constitue and appoint my sons Chaney and Hiram my Executors, to this my Last will and Testament - An Witnesse whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of January in the year of Our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and thirteen -
