one horse one track of Land Whereon I now live likewise

all my Cattle bed and household furniture, and one old Cart,

Likewise I Constitute and appoint John Collins and Samuel

Brice to be my Executor to execute this my My last Will and

testament I renoun all other Wills by me made, and publish<sup>d</sup>
