I leave and bequeath to Ellender Meadows my beloved Wife All my Estate real and personal All my land & tenements Stock Movebles of every Kind, Notes of hand Debts, Dues or demands any Ways to me belonging, during her Widowhood (Except in this my Will Mentioned) and at her Death, to be Sold and devided between my Eight Children Namely George, William, Casander, Benj^m. Matty, Lawson, Genny Ester, as my Executors Sees cause to direct in the devision of my Estate I also bequeath to George Meadows a ^{black} horse to the Value ^{of} thirty dollars I also bequeath to Will^m Meadows my son a Sorrel Mare at thirty dollars the S^d horses to be deducted out of my estate when a divission takes placed also Constitute my beloved Wife Ellender Meadows and George Meadows my son Executors of this my last will and Testament revoking and disanulking all other wills in Writing or otherwise as Witnefs my hand and Seal, this Eight day of February in the Year of Our Lord One Thoud.
