3 all the Rest of my property Real and personal I Leave to my be Loved wife Rebecca turner During her natural Life for her Support and maintenance

4 It is my will and Desire after the Death of my beloved wife Rebecca turner all my Estate Real and personal be Equally Divided between and among all my Children or their Lawfull heirs Share and Share alike.

I hereby Constitute and appoint Joseph price and Joshua Richards Executors of this my Last will and testament and invest them with full power to Divide my Estate as aforesaid without any order of Court Ratifying acknowledging & Confirming the Same this
