In the name of God Amen.

I William Headers of Spartanburg District and State of South Carolina being infirm in Body but of sound mind memory & understanding Thanks to Almighty God for it, do make this my last will & testament--Viz. I give and bequeath to my loving wife Ann Headers the plantation on which I now live with all my household & kitchen furniture with all my live stock I may have at my decease as long as she shall live. To my son Thomas Headers all the woodland in the tract of the branch to him and his heirs forever. To my son John Headers one half of the remainder of the tract of land including the house in which I now live--but not to permit my Daughter Mary Indian to live in the house so long as she shall choose so to do the rest of my land I give and devise to my Grandson John Headers being the lower part of my land to him and his heirs forever--To my Grandson William Hindman one Bay Colt, one feather bed and furniture.

The rest of my personal property to be sold by the direction of my Executors and equally divided be to my Daughters & two sons Viz. Elizabeth Marralson, Jane Smith, Mary Indian, Dorcas Vice Jasec Headers James Headers, Nancy Moore, Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son John Headers whole & Sole Executor of this my last will & testament--In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and the thirty eighth of the Independence of America.
