Spartenburg Destrict being of Sound mind & memory dwo make this  
my Last will and Testament in Manner following, I Recommend  
my Söle into the hands of Allmighty God who gave it and my Body  
I recommend to the Earth to be Intered desently at the Descre-  
-fsion of my Executors heare after named, And as to my Worldly  
Estate, I dispose thereof in the manner following----

Item the 1st I give all my Lands <sup>and</sup> Tenements what soever  
with their appertainances to gither with all my Goods and  
Chattles Moneys due & in hand together with all and Every thing  
that belong to my Estate after my Just debts being paid, Unto  
my Wife Frances Stone during her Life or Widowhood to be at  
her Death or Marrage Equally divided among the hole of My  
Children-----to wit Nancy, John-, William, James, Tilman,  
Seaborn, Cobern, & Mayborn,.

Secondly I will that my two Negrow Men Namly Felix & Dick bee  
set free upon paying to my Executors for the use of my Children  
one hundred Dollars Each, which May be paid with Each paying  
ten dollars per year provided, it may not Sute thier Convenience  
to discharge it sooner, to remain under the Direction of my  
Executors untill the Afore said two hundred dollars shall b  
paid & the said Negroes Shall Recäve thir freedom on the first  
day of January Next so far as to work for them selves & recive  
thier full freedom when the two hundred dollars is paid

Lastly I appint my Wife Frances Stone & Thad. Murray My Executors  
of this my will. & I Revoke all other wills by me heretofore  
made & in Testimony that this is my only true will & Testament  
I have heare unto set my hand and Seal this Second day of July,  
one thousand Eight Hundred & fourteen
