

I Agnes Barber of Watree Creek, Cambden District, Craven County & St. Mark's Parish, being of perfect Mind & memory, but very low in health Calling to mind, that it was Appointed once for all Men to Die, & after Death to Come to Judgment, I resign my Soul to Almighty God, believing that he will raise it to the Judgment of the Last Days, and my body to be Decently Intaired at the Discretion of my Executors, Such worldly Goods as the Lord was pleased to bestow on me, I Give in Manner and form following, Vist. first of all, I give and Bequeath to John Barber one Cow, to John Connery, I give and Bequeath one Cow, for the use of my Three Children, & a Man's saddle & bridle  
 One Grey Colt two years Old past, Named Whitefoot, to be kept use of my Three Children, Namely, Robert, James, and Bethridge to Bethridge Barber I give my feather bed & bed Clothes, all my wearing Apparell & my Spinning Wheel  
 Barber, the remaining part of all my worldly Goods and Chattels of what kind soever to be equally Divided among my three Children, Namely, Robert, James, and Bethridge Barber, after bestowing my Effects in manner and form before Mentioned. I appoint John Barber and John Connery of Watree Creek, Cambden District, Craven County, and St. Mark's Parish, for my whole and Sole Executors, This being <sup>my</sup> last will and testament. Renouncing and Revoking all other Wills and Testaments before made by me.  
 Given under my hand and Seal this Eight Day of October, Anno Domini, one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Four.
