paid to them by my Executors hereafter named when ev r they shall  
demand the Same after my Said Executor hath gotten Possession of  
my part of the Property above mentioned-----

Item, I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters Frances Jane and  
Susannah Bryson, *which I had by my late husband Lefly Bryson* all the Rest and Residue of my Property of whatever  
kind Soever I may be possesed of or Intitled to at the Time of my  
Death to be equally Devided between them Share and Share alike to  
be paid ~~to them~~ to them when they arive to the age of eighteen or  
day of Marriage which may first happen and if either of them Should  
die before that time her Share to Revert to the Surviving one, but  
if both Should die before that age of Day of Marrigge, the Property  
given to them, is to be equally Devided between my Surviving,  
Children, Share and Share, alike Lastly, I nominate, Constitute  
and appoint, my Trusty Friend G<sup>e</sup> Roe peetos Sam<sup>u</sup> E plowden Sole  
Executors of this my last will and Testament---In witnefs whereof  
I have hereunto Sett my hand and Seal, this Second Day of July in  
the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and four-----
