This my last Will and Testament made Sumter Destrict in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty nine Witneseth that I Archy Bell of State and district aforesaid Being Weak in body but of sound mind and beleiving as I do that this mortal must put on immertality I therefore Will and bequeath my landed and perishable property as follows, Viz, I Will and bequeath to my beloved Wife Margaret my land and plantation whereon I now live being Two hundred And Seventy five acres More or lefs During her natural life or Widowhood and at the experations of Either To be equally Divided between my five Children Viz, Benjamin Sumter Bell, Margaret Louisa Bell Ezekeil Dixon Bell, I also Will and bequeath to my beloved Wife Margaret Two Cows and Calves and Two Feather Beds also one horse which she had the liberty of Choosing to be disposed of at her Death as seemen th good unto her I also Will that one hundred and Twenty five Bushels Corn of the present Crop be Reserv to my family also a sufficiency of fodder and Pork to sustain the Family one year from this date- The Balance of my Property not herein mention ed Including my negro boy Simus I, Will, be sold by my Execution my lawfull and just debts paid, and The Remainder, I will & bequeath to my beloved Children to be equally divided between them Viz- John Bell, Celey Amoson, Harriott Bell, Martha Bell, William Wesley Bell, and James Bell, I also appoint John Dixon & James McCallum my lawfull Executors to carry out Thes provision of this my seet will and Testament in whereoff I hereunto sett my hand and This 4th day of October 1839 Signal in presence of
