In the name of God Amen T Charles Amonett of Sumter District Sou Carolina being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God calling into mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Teftament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God who gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be Buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Almighty Power of God and as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to blefs me with I give divise and dispose of the same in the following manner that is to say -----

First I give my Grandson John Buddin one Hundred and forty Acres of land adjoining his land and the remainder of my Plantation I give and disp Grand Son A Buskirk and it is my will and desire that my Hous ements be in fsion of the one that Maintains John Harrell during his life and I also give to the one of my sons in law that shall maintain the St John Harrell twenty five Dollars yearly to be levied and paid out of 1 my movable Estate ---

and my will and desire is that all my movable Estate be sold at be paid out of my estate Public Auction and that money of for to pay the teacher for learning my four Grand Children V12 JohnElizabeth Catharine and William Buddin and the remainder to equally divided among all my Grand Children but my three grand Children V12 Marry Nancy and Judeth School not to receive their part till they become of the age of eighteen years of age and I do make and ordain Thomas Buskirk and Barwell Evans my Executors to Execute and perform my will and I do manu or Almightyudod Othonysverhica and mynspody3-18recommend to the www.southcarolinapioneers.net earth to be Buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Almighty Power of God and as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to blefs me with I give divise and dispose of the same in the following manner that is to say----First I give my Grandson John Buddin one Hundred and forty Acres of land adjoining his land and the remainder of my Plantation I give and disp -- Grand Son A Buskirk and 1t is my will and desire that my Hous ements be in fsion of the one that Maintains John Harrell during his life and I also give to the one of my sons in law that shall maintain the St John Harrell twenty five Dollars yearly to be levied and paid out of my movable Estate --and my will and desire is that all my movable Estate be sold at be paid out of my estate Public Auction and that money ofor to pay the teacher for learning my four Grand Chillen V12 JohnElizabeth Catharine and William Buddin and the remainder to equally divided among all my Grand Children but my three grand Children Viz Marry Nancy and Judeth School not to receive their part till they become of the age of eighteen years of age and I do make and ordain Thomas Buskirk and Barwell Evans my Executors to Execute and perform my will and I do hereby disallow revoke and disannull all wills before made owning this and no other to be my last will and Teft as witness my hand and Seal this the fifteenth of one Thousand eight hundred and two Charles Amonett (SEAL).
